Thank offering 2014

Today is the start of our 2014 Thank Offering appeal. This year we are proposing to split our gifts between two Suffolk causes, Sizewell Hall and CYM's African Adventure.



Just up the coast at Sizewell there is a Christian conference and camping centre that provides a wonderful setting for Churches, Christian youth organisations and schools to hold conferences, retreats and house parties. Since 1975 thousands of people, young and not so young, have stayed at Sizewell Hall and had the opportunity to learn about the Christian Faith. Many are able to testify that whilst there they encountered God in a personal way. The work at Sizewell Hall is underpinned by a team of prayer partners and the Charity relies on financial support from individuals and Churches.

Over the years many Bethesda groups have received benefit from time spent at Sizewell, and we would now like to support them as they seek to improve the facilities that the Hall offers.

AFRICAN ADVENTURE

In the grounds of Sizewell Hall, CYM runs an exciting residential project called 'African Adventure'. This project offers primary school children an outdoor education residential experience in a purpose built African Village in the woodlands. CYM are currently in the process of renovating the site and re-roofing each of the African

Huts. They have plans and ideas to further develop the project to make it more exciting and accessible to other schools. One such idea would see the creation of another building to allow space for more reflection and creative work.

African Adventure provides a great doorway into schools for CYM's children's work and our gifts will help CYM to further develop this exciting opportunity to reach young people.
