What More can I Give?

To maintain the ongoing daily ministries of Bethesda we need weekly giving to regularly average £2,850. Weekly offerings are currently around £300 short of this target and we have had to dip into reserves to make up the shortfall. This is not a situation we can allow to continue indefinitely.

Against this backdrop we recognise the pressing need to redevelop some of our buildings. Should the cost of the works proposed exceed the amount we currently have set aside, no commercial lender would support us unless we can demonstrate an ability to more than cover our regular ongoing expenses.

To support our current programme we need a 13% increase (£300 per week) in our regular giving. Can we ask you, as we ask ourselves, to prayerfully consider these questions?

- Can I commit to regularly support the ministries of Bethesda by monthly bank transfer?
- If I already do this, am I able to increase the monthly amount I give?
- Am I an income tax payer who hasn't signed up to Gift Aid my offerings? This simple step can increase the value given by 25%.
- If I give through the offering am I able to commit to an increased weekly gift?
